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Policy:

Guidelines:

1. Purpose

- 1.1 In line with A1H Group vision to provide the best care possible, the purpose of this Sustainability Policy is to outline A1H Group’s commitment, fundamental principles, and responsibilities to demonstrate sustainable culture and practices across A1H Group’s businesses.
- 1.2 This Policy serves as a guideline to implement A1H Group’s sustainability strategies and approaches in delivering sustainable growth as well as managing sustainability risks & opportunities effectively.

2. Scope

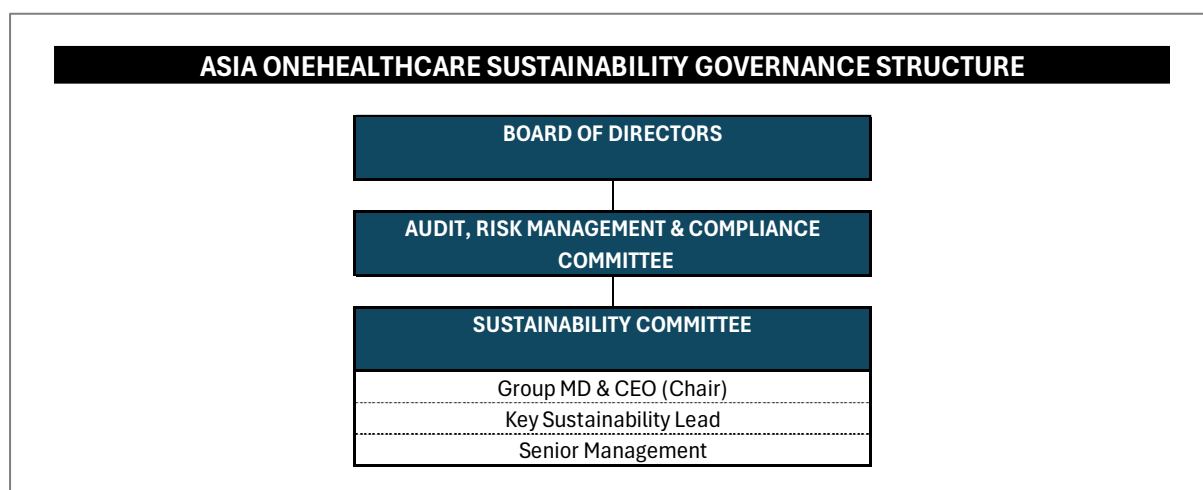
5. Responsibilities:
